

What to know the day of the show:

- Alison will send out a class list the week of the show. It will provide the location of the show, arrival time for riders, the place that we will meet and any special instructions for parents (e.g. here to drop off your saddles).
- Parents are to stay in the arena with the group, not in the warm up area. Older kids can help escort younger riders to the warm up area if needed.
- Riders should bring your <u>clean</u> saddles to the show with you. If your rider is planning to show that week, take your saddle home after your last lesson before the show to clean it.
