Shipping Artwork

Ship artwork using a sturdy, reusable packing materials clearly labeled with your name and telephone number. Do not include return postage in case the artwork sells during the run of the exhibition. Following the exhibition each artist who shipped their work should generate a

Return label and email it to gallery@greensboroart.com so the piece may be returned. Do not use styrofoam packing peanuts. Shipments of artwork will be accepted March 22 - 30.

- Work must be ready to hang or place. (appropriate securely fastened wire or hook able to support the weight of the artwork attached to back of wall hangings, framed or neatly finished edges; 3-D work must be stable and not exceed 50 Lbs) The utmost care will be taken in handling all works. CVA reserves the right to refuse artwork(s) that are not professionally presented.
- The CVA is not responsible for faulty hangers or mounts on framed or unframed works. We have limited liability coverage for theft or natural disaster; it is the artist's responsibility to carry additional insurance for any of their works shown in the exhibition.
- All works should be original, unsold work for sale, unless otherwise agreed with the CVA Gallery. The artist must own sole copyright to any work submitted. CVA receives 40% commission on any work sold.

Entry Information:

All files should be named like so:

01_LASTNAME_TITLE.jpg, 02_LASTNAME_TITLE.jpg

Still images should be sent as jpegs should be 300dpi and at least 1000px on the longest side, not to exceed 2MB per image. 2D artists may submit one JPEG per entry. 3D artists may submit two JPEGS (one full shot and one detail) per entry. Follow the filename format for works as indicated above.
